### **School bus**

We have been informed that parents can apply for private bus tickets for school transport via Acme Transport Services:

This is relevant for children living between Wendens Ambo and Littlebury who are not eligible for free school transport. Using the bus, reduces parking congestion and is better for the environment. The more people who apply for private bus travel, the more likely it is that the bus will continue. The cost last year was £570 and payments can be made in monthly instalments.
