

## Numeracy

- \*Number and place value
- \*Mental addition and subtraction
- \*Mental multiplication and division
- \*Problem solving
- \*Properties of 3d shapes.
- \*Halves and quarters
- \*Measurement of time: minutes, hours, days, weeks, months, years
- \* Measurement of height using non-standard measures

## Art

- \* What is Sculpture? In this unit children develop their understanding of shape, form, texture and the sensory qualities of materials. They learn about the work of sculptors and about different kinds of sculpture.

## History

- \* What Were Homes Like a Long Time Ago? This unit looks at similarities and differences between homes today and homes in the past. They are able to distinguish old from new, and to learn about life at a time beyond living memory.

## PE

- \* Gymnastics - Children investigate movement, stillness, and how to find and use space safely.
- \* Games – Children play games that demand simple decisions on how to use space to avoid opponents, keep the ball and score points.
- \* Swimming - Children learn how to keep afloat, move in the water, meet challenges and breathe when swimming.

Children will recap their understanding of the 5 senses and focus on sound and hearing.
- \*Seasonal change  
This unit will deepen the children's understanding of changes that happen during the year and how the seasons can affect our lifestyles.

## Geography

- \* An Island Home – This unit develops children's understanding of geographical features and offers opportunities for them to express their views about people, places and environments.

## Music

- \* Chanting and rhythm –This unit develops children's ability to use their voices expressively by singing songs, chants and rhymes.
