Each area of learning will have a link which you can use to access the work. Please ensure the maths and English tasks are completed in the morning and the foundation activities (science and topic) in the afternoon, as it would be in school.

One maths and English task should be completed every day. One foundation activity must be completed each day, your child can choose between science and topic. One Religious Education activity needs to be completed each week. Please ensure your child completes a minimum of 2-3 GPS tasks a week and reads a book every day.
