

A selection of activities which may be covered this term in Year 4.

Mathematics

- Number – Continue to consolidate knowledge of multiplication facts to 12x12. Continue to consolidate the formal methods covered so far.
- Fractions – Recognise some common equivalent fractions, add and subtract fractions with the same denominator
- Decimals – Understand the place value for tenths and hundredths, recognise the effect of multiplying or dividing decimals by 10 and 100.
- Money – converting pounds to pence and solving money problems.

Science

- Continue to develop investigative skills.
- Understand how the digestive system works.
- Identify the different types of teeth and their functions.
- Construct a variety of food chains.
- Understand how sounds are made and how we hear them.

English

- Continue the work on the Writing Checklist
- Fiction genres – Fables and character descriptions
- Non-fiction genres – explanations and non-chronological reports
- Poetry – poems in a range of forms
- Reading comprehension
- Spelling patterns/rules

Computing

- Use of Espresso Coding to revise conditional events, introduce variables and use repetitions/loops.
- Use of the Internet for research
- Continue to develop skills in combining software to present and publish work.
