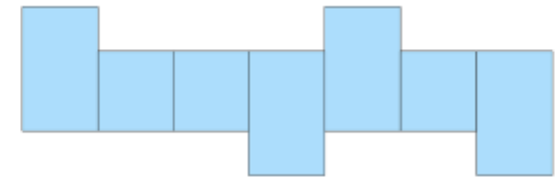


Annie says, "Beaker A contains more water because it is almost full whereas beaker B is less than half full".
