



## Home Learning Tasks for EYFS – Autumn 1

This home learning letter provides your child with learning activities from various areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage to complete at home. Each area of learning will have a link which you can use to access the work. Please ensure the Maths and Communication and Language/Literacy tasks are completed in the morning and Understanding the World or Expressive Arts and Design in the afternoon, as it would be in school.

One maths, communication and language/literacy and phonics lesson should be completed every day. Additionally, please ensure you read with your child every day and practise their sight words or letter sounds.

To access **Discovery Espresso**, **Active Learn** or **Teach Your Monster to Read**, please use the details previously supplied.

<b>Communication and Language/Literacy</b> (20-30 minutes each day)	<a href="https://teachers.thenational.academy/units/little-red-hen-2e6d">https://teachers.thenational.academy/units/little-red-hen-2e6d</a>  Please use the above link to Oak Academy for the daily activity. This is a narrative unit using The Little Red Hen. Each daily lesson provides a learning video to follow with an activity to complete. Start at lesson 1 and continue to work your way through the lessons each day.
<b>Phonics</b> (15 minutes each day)	Login to your Espresso account and select Foundation - Literacy – from here you can select the Phonics section – click on this and select one of the activities from phase 2/3 to play.  You may want to play a game on Teach Your Monsters to Read too.

Each daily lesson provides a learning video to follow with an activity to complete. Start at lesson 1 and continue to work your way through the lessons each day.  You may also want to play a game on Active Learn.
<b>Understanding the world</b> (20 minutes twice a week)	Follow the daily lessons from Oak Academy. <b>Reading For Pleasure</b> (20minutes each day)	Read a book of your choice with an adult.
<b>Physical Exercise</b> (30 minutes each day)	Use this link for a number of suggested physical activities to complete at home. <b>Expressive Arts and Design</b> (30 minutes twice per week)	Make a model using recycling materials. Create some autumn themed art work, for example, paint a picture of your garden or a tree in autumn. Be creative with playdough – what can you make?
<b>RE/Understanding the World</b> (x 30 minutes once per week)	Find out more about Harvest by watching the clips on Discovery Espresso. They include a retelling of the Little Red Hen too! Talk about what you have noticed or can remember from the clip. There are also some activities to have a go at too. Type “Harvest” into the search bar and then click on the Harvest module to access the clips and the activities.
<b>PSED</b>	What makes a good friend? Draw a picture of yourself and ask an adult to write down what makes you a good friend to others.
<b>Independent play</b>	Get your toys out and play!
