You should then choose a timetable challenge to complete (A, B or C).

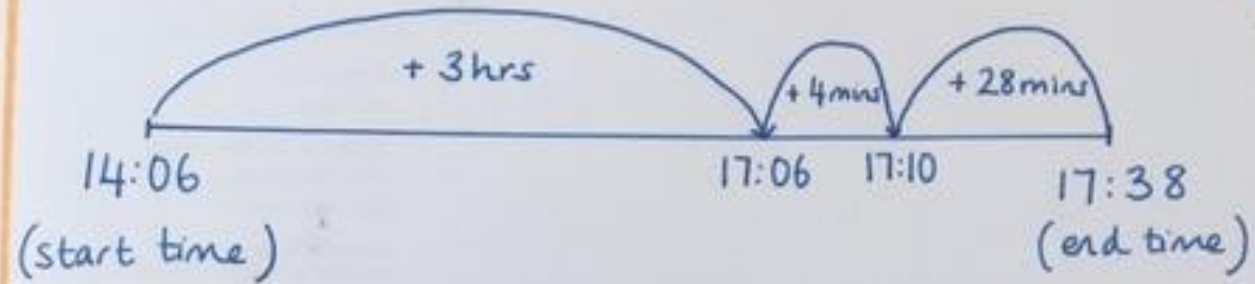
Please draw any tables neatly into your books. Remember, when calculating time intervals you should use a number line to help.

Time intervals

e.g

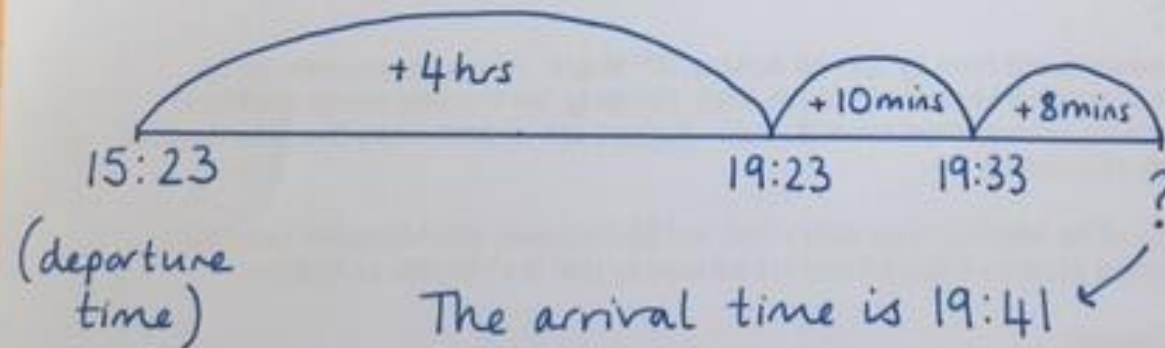
To find the duration of this journey...



$$3 \text{ hrs} + 4 \text{ mins} + 28 \text{ mins} = 3 \text{ hrs } 32 \text{ mins}$$

Or e.g

To find the arrival time...  
(Journey takes 4 hrs 18 mins)

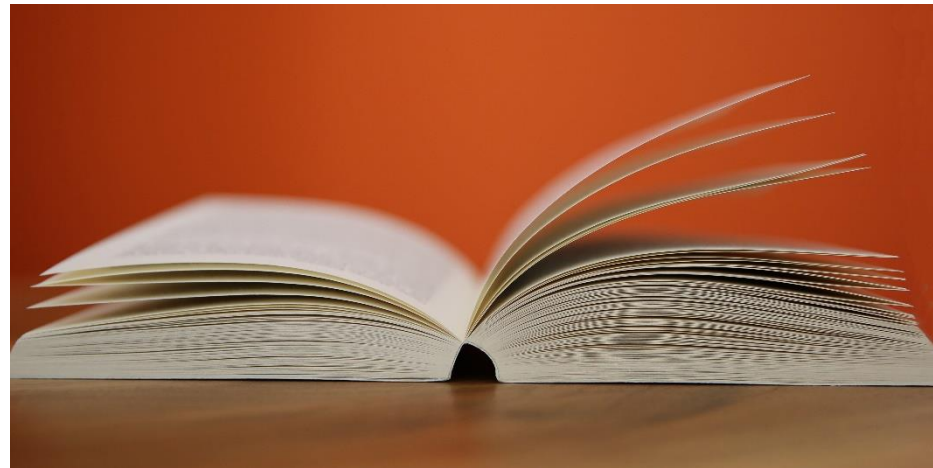

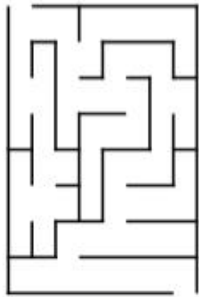
