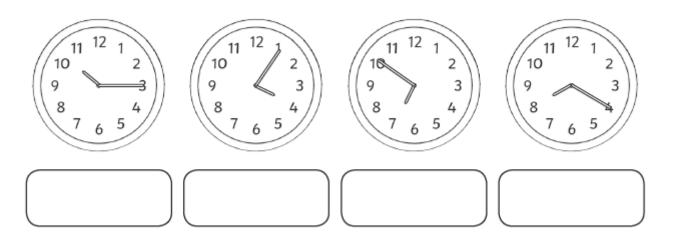

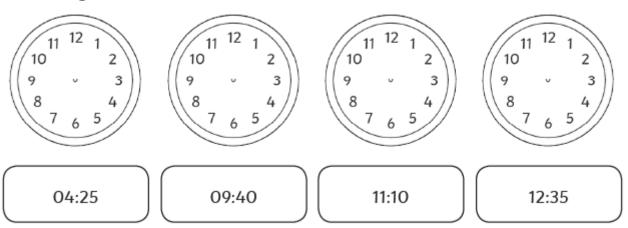

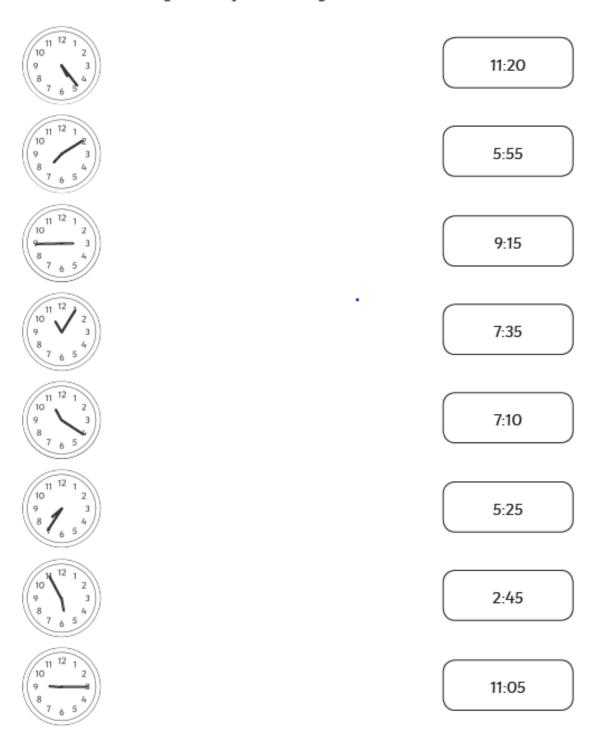
1. What time is showing on these clock faces?
