
## **Annual School Reports**

The Royal British Legion is calling on the nation to mark the 75th anniversary of VE Day from home. They are inviting us all to join them on Friday 8th May to support them in paying tribute to the service of the entire Second World War generation, from British, Commonwealth and Allied Forces to evacuees and those who served on the home front. The Royal British Legion is playing a central role in the delivery of a range of remote activity, including:
