Vocabulary:

- What does this word tell you about?
- Why do you think the author chose this word?
- Can you find any adjectives in the text?
- How does this word make you feel?

Retrieving information:

- Where is the story set?
- How does the story end?
- Which information do you find the most interesting and why?
- Can you think of a different title for this information/chapter?

Sequencing:

- How/where does the story start?
- What happened next?
- How did the text end?
- Use 20 words to sum up this story/non-fiction text.

Inference:

- What do you think the author meant when ...?
- Can you explain why ...?
- Why do you think he/she ...?
- What do you think the word ... means? Why do you think that?

Prediction:

- What do you think will happen next?
- What do you think this book/chapter/section will be about?
- Draw what you think might happen next.
- How do you think this will end?

Maths

Regular practice of counting in steps of 2, 5, 10 and 3, forwards and backwards.

Rapid recall of number bonds to 10, 20 and 100.

Telling the time to the nearest quarter hour.
